Text: 2 Samuel 6

Outline:

- 1) How does the passage in 2 Samuel 6 correct your view of God?
 - a. Do you tend to view God as more holy or more gracious?
- 2) How should understanding the holiness of God affect the way you live?
- 3) How should understanding the grace of God affect the way you live?
- 4) How are these 2 attributes of God reflected in the gospel?

Title: Leaving a Legacy Compelled by the Sovereignty of God

Text: Ephesians 1:3-6

Outline:

5 Soul-Stirring Truths about God's Sovereignty in Salvation

- 1) Election's Basis: **The Bible**
- 2) Election's Goal: **Holiness & Adoption**
- 3) Election's Timing: **Before Creation**
- 4) Election's Motivation: **Love**
- 5) Election's Purpose: **God's Glory**

Questions:

- 1) Why might someone find the idea that God is sovereign over salvation to be offensive or hard to believe?
- 2) How does understanding God's sovereignty in election affect the way you view God and your own salvation?
- 3) How should understanding God's sovereignty in election affect the way you think and live?

Session #3

Title: Leaving a Legacy Unstained by the Sinfulness of Sin

Text: Romans 1:18-32

Outline:

3 Reasons Why Sin Is So Sinful

- 1) Sin is **Without Excuse** (1:18-21)
- 2) Sin is an **Idolatrous Exchange** (1:22-25)
- 3) Sin is **Outwardly Expressed** (1:26-32)

Questions:

- 1) In your own words, what makes sin so sinful?

- 2) Is sin first and primarily an internal issue or an external issue? In other words, is sin primarily a problem of the mind and heart or a problem of action and behavior?
- 3) How would you explain sin to someone who is unfamiliar with the Bible?
- 4) How should understanding the sinfulness of sin affect the way you think and live?

Title: Leaving a Legacy Centered Upon the Word of God

Text: 2 Timothy

Outline:

4 Marks of a Life Centered Upon the Word of God

- 1) **Recognize** the **Nature** of God's Word
- 2) **Understand** the **Meaning** of God's Word
- 3) **Submit** to the **Authority** of God's Word
- 4) **Pass On** the **Treasure** of God's Word

- 2) What are some ways that the Word of God can be more central to your life?
- 3) How will you pass on the truth of God to the next generation?
