


Worship And Transformation Time October 10, 2021

- What troubles happened to Job?
- How did he respond? What did he do? What didn't he do?

- It's ok to talk to God about your troubles- He wants you to focus on Him and accept it as training. Remember such a time and say a prayer of thanks to God who is in control.


